Location & Dates

The conference will convene at the University of Western Australia Business School. The conference reception will be held on the evening of Wednesday, 3 July. Conference sessions will commence on Thursday, 4 July, and run through to lunchtime on Saturday, 6 July.

Requirements

There are no particular prerequisites or study requirements other than, being a full time student, having an understanding of economics and or law. However, given the applied nature of the topics, this will be suited to advanced undergraduates, or post graduate students.
