The successful applicant will experience public policy outside their own environment and learn about the workings of the most economically free country in the world (<http://www.heritage.org/index/ranking>). They will also have the opportunity to visit the prestigious Asian Society (<http://asiasociety.org/>).

### **Location**

Hong Kong

### **Requirements**

Applicants must have an interest in free market principles and strong communication skills. There are no particular prerequisites or study requirements (other than being enrolled as a current UWA Business School student). Studying economics is a plus, though not a necessity.

### **Costs**

The successful applicant will receive funding for their internship through UWA. The internship will include flights, accommodation and a small stipend.

### **Application Process**

Before applying, students are to examine LRI's website (<http://www.lionrockinstitute.org/english/index.php>).
